



SOC Monthly Meeting: June 16th, 1 p.m. on Webex

According to the National Institutes of Health, LGBTQ+ youth are over 4 times more likely to attempt suicide than their non-LGBTQ+ peers. This disparity stems in part from elevated rates of rejection, bullying, systemic discrimination, and more.

The Trevor Project 2024 national survey on LGBTQ youth found that 53 to 66% of LGBTQ youth reported experiencing increasing anxiety and depression with 84% wanting access to mental health services, but 50% could not access those critically needed services for various reasons (<https://www.thetrevorproject.org/survey-2024/>).
